

Dr. Paul Kollman, C.S.C., a Catholic priest of the Congregation of Holy Cross, teaches theology at the University of Notre Dame. He has served as director of Notre Dame's Center for Social Concerns, as president of the American Society of Missiology and International Association for Mission Studies, and has taught in Kenya and Uganda. A trustee at Saint Mary's College, the University of Notre Dame, and Tangaza University College, Nairobi, Kollman's research focuses on African Christianity, mission history, and world Christianity, focusing on eastern Africa.
